you can try this for the first question

```
1)SELECT DEPARTMENT AS DEPARTMENT, SUM(CASE SEX WHEN 'MALE THEN 1 ELSE 0
END )) AS MALE ,SUM(CASE SEX WHEN 'FEMALE' THEN 1 ELSE 0 END)) AS FEMALE AS CNT
FROM EMPLOYEE GROUP BY DEPARTMENT
```

or

```
1)SELECT DEPARTMENT AS DEPARTMENT, SUM(CASE WHEN SEX = 'MALE THEN 1 ELSE 0
END )) AS MALE ,SUM(CASE WHEN SEX='FEMALE' THEN 1 ELSE 0 END)) AS FEMALE AS CNT
FROM EMPLOYEE GROUP BY DEPARTMENT
```
